Our Mission: Committed to the principle of ensemble performance through the collaboration of a company of actors, directors and playwrights, Rising Sun Performance Company's (RSP) mission is to advance the vitality and diversity of American theater by nurturing artists, encouraging repeatable creative relationships, and contributing new works and revitalized pre-existing work to the national canon. Rising Sun Performance Company realizes this goal by providing a safe artistic home which stimulates risk-taking without limits of genre or agenda.



Founded in September of 2001, RSP is an established Indie theatre company dedicated to producing ensemble-based work. It is run by artists for artists to allow them to create their own opportunities instead of their opportunities creating them. RSP is the full time artistic home for a wide range of theatre artists, including actors, writers, directors, designers, singers, and dancers. 2019 marks the beginning of RSP's 18th producing season, culminating in 300 plus productions and events. This includes the development of 16 world debut plays, over 100 One Act Plays as part our annual series, a musical cabaret series, free outdoor performances, children's theatre, immersive themed theatrical experiences and its trademark revivals, including sold out critically acclaimed hits: The Shape of Things, An Adult Evening of Shel Silverstein, Hellcab, The Last Supper, Fool for Love, Bug and The Glory of Living.

RSP offers internships in all areas of theatre production

Interns will have the opportunity to have an active hand in all aspects of RSP's season, with options of focused or combined track internship.

- Arts Administration: General & Business Management, Fundraising & Development, Publicity & Audience Development, Box Office Operations & Casting
- Design: Costume, Scenic, Sound, Lights and Properties
- Dramaturgy & Literary Management
- Casting & Direction
- Stage & Production Management
- Production: Properties, Set Construction, Run Crew and Board Operation

Program participants will be partnered with a staff member who will act as both supervisor and mentor, and help to oversee that the experience is customized to support each intern's educational and career goals. Interns are given a high level of responsibility and will be assigned projects to both assist and manage over the duration of their time with RSP.

From season & script selection, new play development, casting, rehearsals, load in, performance to load out, interns will be at the bustling center of it all.

Interns are included in all ensemble events, meetings, and production opportunities, and are also encouraged to take advantage of the many community and networking opportunities that RSP offers.



This is an intensive hands-on program, and interns must be willing to work and learn in a grassroots type environment.

Applicants should have strong interest in pursuing a career in theatre arts. All candidates must be extremely selfmotivated, and organized while also being flexible. Have great communication skills and ability to maintain and work within a small budget and meet deadlines, work under pressure and well within a team environment.

Internships are non-paid positions. Interns will be able to participate at no cost in theatre workshops, classes. Ensemble lab sessions, and will receive free tickets to RSP's season. Small Monthly Stipend is possible for some roles.

RSP will provide all letters required for school credit and letter of reference for future job searches as well as any other career assistance as possible. Small Monthly Stipend possible for some internships.

3, 6 & 12 Month Internships offered

10 to 30 hours per week, depending on position and time period within our season. Some Weekends and Evenings are required.
