














THE PLAYWRIGHTS

Judd Lear Silverman (playwright) is a Berrilla Kerr Foundation grant recipient and has been published by ArtAge, Samuel French, Stage It!, the Pirandello Society of America, and Applause Theatre Books' *Best American Short Plays* series among others. His plays can also be found on the New Play Exchange (NPX). Recent presentations of his work have been seen at the KNOW Theatre in Binghamton, NY (Audience Award) and presented in NYC by groups such as Village Playwrights, Articulate Theatre Company, Plays and Pizza, PlayGround Experience, and Brooklyn's Gallery Players; recent regional credits include Bonita Springs FL's Stage It! Festival, KY's Theatre Workshop of Owensboro, and both the 2019 and 2020 Mid-America Theatre Conferences in Cleveland and Chicago respectively. He is a member of the Dramatists Guild and teaches Playwriting, Drama Lit, and English at Pace University. www.juddlearsilverman.com.

Kati Frazier (Playwright) is a playwright, dramaturg, and theater administrator from North Carolina, now based in Brooklyn. They have a deep artistic interest in magical realism, non-linear timelines, liminal spaces, and the queering of structure. Their plays include: 'Virtue Of Fools,' 'The Last Year,' '15 Feet: A Story Told From A Distance,' 'The Couch,' 'Patronage,' "a sex thing (or, a bunch of liberals get uptight about the sociopolitical implications of their desires),' and 'Untitled Calamity Jane Play'. Their work has been seen at City Arts, Greensboro Fringe Festival, The Players Theatre, Brooklyn's The Brick, Random Access Theater, HERE, Oracle Performing Arts, LREI, and more. Their short plays 'Girlfight' and 'My Emotions Are Too Big For This Room' were published by Smith & Krauss.

Michael Hagins (Playwright) is an African-American Playwright, Director, Fight Director, Actor, and Producer. Michael is a Member of Dramatists Guild and an Advanced Actor-Combatant for the Society of American Fight Directors. Michael was born in Brooklyn, New York, but raised in a small town in Florida for his childhood. He has used the racism and prejudice he dealt with at an early age to fuel his writing, which he has done so since the age of 9. Michael is an avid lover of Shakespeare (he has done every play in the Shakespeare Canon) and has performed, directed and taken part in over 1,000 plays and films over his artistic career. Molly Kirschner (Playwright) is a playwright and poet. She is a resident playwright of Rising Sun Performance Company. Her play L'appel du Vide was produced at UNDER St. Marks Theater in New York City in 2017. A monologue from this play was included in Best Men's Stage Monologues 2018, edited by Lawrence Harbison. Her play Vagabonds had a staged reading at The Kraine Theater in New York City for the 2019 Estrogenius Festival, and has received further development through Estrogenius. Previously, this play was read at Dixon Place in New York City in 2016, and was included in the 2017 Soundings Reading Series at Writers Theatre of New Jersey. Kirschner's poems have appeared or are forthcoming in numerous journals including the Southern Review and the New Ohio Review, and in Italian translation. Her new manuscript, Your Body Does the Work of Wings, was a semi-finalist for the Louise Bogan 2020 Award for Artistic Merit and Excellence. Kirschner's first book of poems, Hard Proof, was released in July of 2015 from Red Mountain Press. Her second collection, Notes For Further Research, was released in December 2017. Recent new work development include the NYC workshop of A Self Help Guide to Killing Your Boss, a new musical by Justin Smalls and Caroline Dunaway (Alchemical Theater Lab) and the first workshop of Hold My Spot by Amir Muhammad (Latea Theatre at The Clemente) — the latter of which she was nominated for '"Outstanding Direction of a Staged Reading" & "Outstanding Use of Multimedia" at Planet Connections Theatre Festivity. Anna has assistant directed Off Broadway and off-off Broadway, including her most recent endeavour with Obie-winning playwright and Oscar Nominee José Rivera on his World Premiere of Lovesong, Imperfect. Anna is the proud creator of *Playwrights LAIR*, a new artist in residency program!
